INDIANA PRIMARY ELECTION INFORMATION:

New Primary Election date is **June 2, 2020**

Voter registration deadline for the June 2 Primary Election is **Monday, May 4**

Absentee Ballot applications are due **May 21**

ABSENTEE BALLOT APPLICATIONS MUST BE FILED BEFORE YOU CAN BE SENT AN ABSENTEE BALLOT

Absentee Ballots are due **June 2, Election Day, at NOON**

The return mailing address for each county election board or county clerk is available on page 2 of the absentee ballot application. The absentee application may also be returned by fax or email attachment.

Be sure to fill out the highlighted areas of the application with your information, including your county of residence.

It's a primary election, you'll need to declare a party.

Be sure to sign and date the application. A real signature is necessary, even for applications that are emailed or faxed to your county election office.

APPLICATION FOR ABSENTEE BALLOT FOR JUNE 2, 2020, PRIMARY ELECTION ONLY

(ABS-MAIL PRIMARY 2020)

INSTRUCTIONS: Complete and return application so it is received by county election board at least twelve (12) days before election day. **DEADLINE:** For the June 2, 2020, Primary Election, deadline for county to RECEIVE is **MAY 21, 2020, BY 11:59 p.m.** (local prevailing time). For the June 2, 2020, primary election, a voter does not need to indicate a reason. If a voter has already submitted an ABS-MAIL application for the original primary date of May 5, 2020, there is no need to resubmit an application for the primary election. The original request will be reviewed by county election officials. **THIS APPLICATION CAN BE MAILED, E-MAILED, FAXED, OR HAND-DELIVERED.** If you receive this completed application from a voter, you must file the completed application with the county or Indiana Election Division by noon, ten (10) days after receiving it or by the absentee deadline, whichever comes first. You must provide the date you received the completed application in box 5.
